

This is a report about a fun project that we did with the children from Pittenweem Primary school and the Pittenweem Community Council in March 2023.



Two stars and A Wish

We wanted to know what the children liked about Pittenweem and what they thought could be even better. So, we ran an activity called "Two Stars and A Wish".

The children were asked to think of two things they really liked about Pittenweem ("two stars") and one thing they wanted to change or improve ("a wish").

This way, they could share their good experiences and tell us what they thought could be improved.

Wishes

Wish	Response rate
Encourage more business including shops and restaurants (including a new chippy) into Pittenweem	39
Bring back the skate park	10
Make play park better	9
Adventurous play activities such as laser tag, paint ball, roller coasters and water slides	7
Create a museum (about the history of Pittenweem and about medieval and Viking history)	5
Reduce litter and offer better bins and recycling	5
Make the school park bigger/new school park	4
Build a water fountain to play in	4
Put flood lights on the tennis court	3

We asked the primary school pupils to join in the project, so we can hear from lots of different people and get lots of ideas.

The 'Two Stars and a Wish' activity helped us learn more about what the young people like about Pittenweem and what they want to change.
