Matters Arising:

Planning: Reported that there were 4 New Applications and 7 Permitted.

Local Councillor's Report: A meeting is being held in Waid on the 20th regarding the proposed closure of the Out of Hours Provision.

It was also reported that repairs to the Tolbooth (Clock Tower?) will be more than the funds in the Common Good account.

NTHC: there is nothing new to report on the new lease. An application has been made for funding to replace the emergency back-up batteries.
